Railway Improvement Works - Track Renewal between Waddon and Wallington

I am writing to let you know that we will be carrying out essential improvement works near your property between Waddon and Wallington.

This work will involve replacing the old conductor rail (the live rail that supplies the power to the trains) and renewing the ballast using on track machinery and engineering trains. During these works there will be some noisy equipment, lighting, and generators on site. You may also hear train horns being sounded; this is because we need to alert staff on track, of all train movements in the area.

Work will take place as follows:

00:45 7 June 2022	05:10 7 June 2022	Preparation work for rail delivery train
00:45 8 June 2022	05:10 8 June 2022	Rail delivery train to offload conductor rails
00:45 9 June 2022	05:10 9 June 2022	Preparation work for installing the new conductor rails
00:45 10 June 2022	05:10 10 June 2022	Preparation work for installing the new conductor rails
02:00 18 June 2022	04:00 20 June 2022	Installing new conductor rails and renewing the ballast.

We understand the affect our activities may have and we can assure you that our teams are briefed on working responsibly within your community. We will only operate machinery when required and endeavour to keep any noise to an absolute minimum, though some disturbance may be unavoidable due to the nature of the work.

Delivering the highest standards of safety is paramount to our work and keeping people safe on and around the railway is at the heart of everything we do. Often, work needs to be carried out while trains are not running. We're obliged to work, whenever possible, at times that cause the least disruption to



train services. Unfortunately, this means carrying out a lot of our improvements during the night and at weekends.
